Admission / Entrance to Club

The Members' Club is situated on the first floor of Olympic Studios. The entrance is opposite the Sweet Shop.

On arrival at the Club, Members must present their membership card at reception and sign themselves and their guests in.

Members must call ahead and leave guests' names on the guest list if they expect their guests to arrive before them.

If the Member has not arrived within an hour, the guest may be asked to leave the Club.

GUESTS

Annual Members may bring a guest into the Club.

Should you wish to bring more than one guest, you must book a table before arrival by calling 0208 912 5174 or emailing: *club@olympiccinema.co.uk*

Right of entry is at the discretion of the management. Management reserve the right to refuse admission to the Club to any Member or guest.

If the conduct of any Member, or their guests, breaches the Club's etiquette rules, the management reserve the right to eject the offending individuals from the premises and/or terminate that Member's membership.

The management are required under various laws and regulations not to exceed the designated capacity of the premises. Once capacity has been reached the management shall operate a "one out, one in" policy.

Occasionally, areas of the Club may be reserved and entrance to Members may be restricted.

CHILDREN

The Members' Club is an adults-only space. However, under 18s are welcome on Saturday and Sunday, and bank holidays until 5pm.

At certain times, an area may be designated for children. We ask those bringing children into the Club to consider other Members at all times.

CLUB ETIQUETTE

All devices must be on silent at all times. Members are permitted to use mobile phones as long as they do so discreetly.

Members should treat all staff and other fellow Members as they would wish to be treated themselves.

The use of cameras or recording equipment is not permitted in the Members' Club, except by prior arrangement.

Members are responsible for the behaviour of their guests.

Any Member who wilfully removes, damages or destroys any property belonging to the Club, or to Members or guests on the premises, will be liable to expulsion.

All bills must be paid in full before leaving the Members' Club.

Members are responsible for their guests' bills if they are not paid.

Noise: good relations with our neighbours is of prime importance to us. We would ask all Members to be conscious of this at all times when leaving the Olympic, especially at night.

Animals, with the exception of guide dogs, are not permitted in the Club.

Matters discussed in the Members' Club, or matters pertaining to the Members' Club, its Members or their guests may not be used for commercial or journalistic purposes, nor disclosed via the internet, or to any third party. Conversations held or overheard must be held in the strictest confidence.

Items lost or found on the premises will be logged at reception. Where the owner can be identified, they will be contacted as soon as possible. Items will be held on site for one calendar month, after which time uncollected items will be donated to charity or disposed of. The Olympic bears no responsibility over the loss of any property by Members or guests.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

- 1 Failure to pay annual subscription within one month of the due date, after being notified by the membership department will result in the Member being refused admission to the Club and membership terminated.
- 2 No Member or guest shall use, ingest, possess or distribute illegal drugs while on the premises. Any person breaching this policy will be asked to leave the Club immediately and, in the case of Members, their membership may be terminated (in accordance with the disciplinary procedure). Members are responsible for the behaviour of their guests: if the guest of a Member breaches the stated drugs policy, the Member will also be subject to the Club's disciplinary procedures.
- 3 If a Member infringes the rules of the Olympic or is considered guilty of misconduct towards staff or a fellow Member, he or she may be required to give an explanation and risk suspension or expulsion. Complaints of misconduct or misbehaviour from Members should be made in writing to the General Manager of the Club.
- 4 Any conduct that is prejudicial to the reputation and character of the Club may result in an expulsion. Such conduct may include, but is not limited to, violent or abusive behaviour and the communication of information concerning the affairs of the Club or its Members and their guests to the media.
- 5 Disciplinary Committee. Two members of the management team will meet when necessary and call for further evidence, witnesses etc when needed. The member who is the subject of the complaint will then be invited to explain what happened. The committee will then decide whether to dismiss the complaint, give warning, suspend or expel the Member. All of this will be done in the strictest of confidence.

We welcome your feedback. Should any Member wish to make a suggestion about how any aspect of the Club can be improved, please put them in writing for the consideration of the General Manager.

DISCLAIMER

Olympic Members' Club shall not be liable for any loss or injury to any Member or any guest or to any goods or property of either party on the premises of Olympic Members' Club unless due to negligence or misconduct on behalf of the Olympic Members' Club or its employees. This disclaimer does not purport to override any statutory liability which may apply and nothing shall exclude or limit liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence. Members should not leave any item overnight at the Olympic, as the Club will not be liable.

INTERPRETATION OF THESE RULES

In the event of any dispute arising as to the meaning or interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Management Team, whose decision shall be final. The management reserves the right to make amendments to the Olympic Members' Club Rules at any time without prior consultation. A copy of the Club rules may be obtained from the Membership Manager upon request.
